Guidelines for Artists

*We're delighted that you have chosen to share
your artistic talent with us!*

1. When beginning a work of art, think about which of the themes your work will address and how you will convey this to the audience.
2. Think about how your art could move beyond a literal interpretation of the theme you choose by taking a more abstract approach—there is no single “correct” way to create your art so consider various possibilities.
3. Sometimes you will create something instantly that you know you will want to enter. Other times you will create several different works and decide between them which you think is best. Take the time you need before submitting your entry.
4. Give your artwork an original, creative title. Generally speaking, the theme you choose from the given list, for either a painting, a sculpture, or a photograph, should NOT serve as the title for your entry.
5. Please submit a photograph of your finished work and submit that, as this prevents the chance that your original work will be damaged or lost.
6. Take a close look at the Torrance Legacy Visual Arts Awards Rubrics which are used in judging. You may find them to be helpful resources.
