## **Protocol for Approved Visitors**

Dear Campus Visitor,

Knox is an hospitable community and has long welcomed visitors to our historic and beautiful campus. In this time of COVID-19, we are taking special measures to protect the health of visitors to our campus as well as members of our campus community. We appreciate your compliance with these measures. # 1. Pre-Arrival Symptom Monitoring

Visitors must complete self-monitoring before arriving on campus, including a temperature check. You must be free of ANY symptom potentially related to COVID-19. At this time, the CDC indicates that these include one or more of the following:

- Fever (above 100.4) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea
- Known exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

If you have any of the above symptoms, please reschedule your visit to campus.

# 2. Check-In

All visitors must check in at their designated location (Alumni Hall for Admission visitors, Administrative Services Building for everyone else). Upon arrival to campus, Admission visitors should call (309) 341-7100. All other visitors should call (309) 341-7979.

- The above phone numbers will be posted outside the building for your convenience.
- A staff member will come outside to take your temperature and ask you a few basic questions about your symptoms and any potential exposure to COVID-19.
- If you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or have been recently exposed to someone who has tested positive, you will be asked to reschedule your visit and depart campus.

#### 3. Masks

Visitors to Knox College are required to wear masks on campus at all times (indoors and outdoors). Please bring a mask to campus with you. If you do not have access to a mask, one will be provided for you upon check in.

# 4. Physical Distancing

Everyone is asked to keep a minimum of 6 feet between themselves and others at all times. Additionally, please restrict your movement on campus to the area designated by your host.

## 5. Handwashing

Everyone is asked to wash their hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after being in a public place or after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing or touching your face. If soap and water are not readily available, use one of the hand sanitizer dispensers on campus.

## 6. Post-Visit Follow Up
