### Visiting Assistant Professor of Spanish

The Spanish Program in the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures at Knox College invites applications for a full-time Visiting Assistant Professor of Spanish beginning September 1, 2019. We seek a specialist in Latin American literary and cultural studies with an emphasis on the Caribbean or Mexico and Central America. The successful candidate will be able to teach all levels of Spanish language, intermediate culture courses with a preference for the Caribbean, as well as upper-level literature courses. The teaching load is six courses per year (two per trimester). Knox College is particularly interested in qualified candidates who can contribute to the diversity and inclusivity of our community through teaching, research and service.

Review of applications begins May 15, 2019 and will continue until position is filled. Applications should be sent (Word and PDF format preferred) to [Interfolio](mailto:Interfolio) and should include (1) Letter of application addressing undergraduate liberal arts teaching philosophy and research agenda and (2) Curriculum Vitae.
