THE GUARDIANS ARE PEOPLE OF AFRICAN DESCENT TELLING STORIES OF WHAT FARMING HAS DONE TO COCONUT PALMS, AND SHRIMP AS THEIR ANCESTRAL HOME AND FOOD SOURCE UNTIL THE SHRIMPING FARMS DEVASTATED NEARLY 90% OF THE FOREST.
